Pupil Premium: Our pupil premium pupils (32 pupils) achieved better than non-pupil premium (27 pupils). 25% of PP achieved 9-4 in English and Maths compared to 18.5% of non-pupil premium.

Gender: Females (31 pupils) outperformed males (28 pupils). Only 10.7% of males achieved 9-4 in English and Maths compared with 32.3% of females.

Free School Meals: FSM pupils (32 pupils) outperformed the non-FSM (27 pupils) pupils with 25% of FSM pupils achieving 9-4 in English and Maths compared to 18.5% of non FSM pupils.

Looked After Children (LAC): With the low numbers of Looked after pupils (3 pupils) it is difficult to effectively compare their performance but the results indicate that LAC pupils have achieved better than non LAC.
